



OPEN THE DOOR TO A CAREER IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

The West Virginia State Police will test for Trooper recruits in July 2014 at the following location:

July 12, 2014 (Saturday – 9:00 a.m.)	WV State Police Academy, Dunbar

Applicants should report to the testing site on the date of your choice and bring a completed Application for West Virginia State Trooper (except if you previously submitted an application and it is already on file), valid photo ID, running shoes, and appropriate exercise attire. Applicants are encouraged to attend the early test dates and do not be late.

You will be required to pass a physical ability test prior to being eligible to take a fourteen-minute written test. A suitability test will be administered on this same day to applicants who successfully pass both the physical ability and written tests. Information reference the physical ability requirements along with a sample of the written test is available at www.wvsp.gov. The suitability test consists of some reading, writing and mathematical skill abilities as well as the completion of personal and life history information. There is no study guide available for this test. Applicants advancing to the suitability test can plan to stay all afternoon and lunch will be provided. No enlistments will be made at this time and applicants should make plans to return to their home immediately following testing.

SALARY: \$2832.83 per month (\$33,994 annual); \$3438.17 per month upon Academy graduation (\$41,258 annual). Competitive benefits package including life and health insurance, retirement, paid holidays, paid vacations, veterans' incentive and more.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS: 21-39 years of age at time of enlistment and a high school diploma or GED. Applicants may test at age 20 with the understanding that they must be 21 prior to the tentative enlisted date of December 1, 2014. Additional qualifications are listed on our website.
